
FY23 saw rapid growth for MAGIC as we launched our most ambitious program, the Autonomous Robotics Innovation Center (ARIC) - a 5,600 sq ft facility that houses robotics STEM education programs, robotics clubs, testing environments and industry collaboration in the interest of workforce development.


